Responsibilities:

- Provide for and ensure child safety, care, and well-being in the classroom environment.

- Create weekly lesson plans for classroom instruction.
- Model compassion, empathy, care, and respect for each child through actions and words.
- Provide appropriate physical care for children. Depending on the age and need, this may include diapering, feeding, and general physical care.
- Communicate effectively with other adults serving students within the educational environment, including other teachers, co-teachers, therapists, parents, and administrators.
- Using an online communication app, provide ongoing detailed information about each child's day with parents.

Required Work Experience:

- Prior experience as a lead teacher in a preschool environment is required.
